Overall job objectives Responsible for Nodis product manufacturing, supplier management, product delivery, product, supplier and customer quality management and processes.

Core responsibilities

- Establish and Manage NODIS manufacturing, QA, Product Engineering capabilities and team
- Provide direction, support, and supervision to four production associates to assure consistent, high-quality, production
- Interface with Product Manager, take ownership of customer fulfillment, and assure production quality goals, volume, and schedules are met
- Manage the overall business relationship with our fabrication partners, driving them to perform on production pricing, capacity, and cycle-time, along with measuring their performance and providing timely feedback to them in order to meet Nodis' expectations.
- Assist with pricing negotiations and maintaining the supplier price book for current and future pricing.
- Generate PR's and tracks PO issuance, follow up with the foundries on any disconnects between supplier commit dates and NODIS required dates.
- Support the film forecasting process and help to drive closure between NODIS forecast and the supplier support plan.
- Facilitate meetings with yield engineering, materials technology, and quality to address any production issues – for example, lot holds, wafer RMA's, and supplier excursions
